I have received from Barry – W9UCW, who sent materials from WB9NUL (SK) and pictures from Jim – W8FNW for inclusion to the records/website. I have been working with Bob – KA9JAC to submit/insert items into the MARAC website. Thank you, Bob for your assistance in updating the website.

During a review of some membership data in the on-line database I discovered a couple errors/omissions in the information posted. When I researched the old paper records (B&B Shop) to find the information I discovered additional omissions in information posted to the on-line database. In my opinion, it's important to recognize all of the members who have joined/supported and contributed to the success of MARAC, by having their information as accurate as possible in the database. I have received data from Barry - K2MF and Don - K3IMC and using that as starting point have constructed a database using their database and verification with the old paper (B&B Shop) data which should more accurately reference membership data. As your MARAC North Central Director, I also have an added responsibility to oversee

the Information Technology Team. This Team is a dedicated volunteer group of MARAC Members who are working together to move the MARAC Awards Programs

and Logger 2 Program into the future. Each has a unique skill that may have been learned in the commercial world or on their own, to improve the current Awards processing and Logger 2 programming.

The IT Team works in the background to help with Logger 2 programming, testing and support. Membership updates and corrections are done on a monthly basis. This database is used for member lookups, Logger updates, award information and much more.

Migration to Logger 2 continues with over 100 conversions and new installations.. Added functionality continues and implemented as it completes testing. New functions are easily added with a quick update. A recent major upgrade to Logger 2 is the interface with WSJT-X software to work counties with FT8. Many are using this added function to enhance the County Hunting experience.

Upgrade to Logger 2 is an easy update. Email K3IMC to get on the installation schedule. If you are already a Logger user, there is no upgrade fee.

I would ask if you have problems with Awards or Logger 2, please use the current method

of problem reporting. Instead of posting on the forum, reach out directly to Dave, KE3VV, who will screen your problem for an existing fix and help you with a resolution.

If you have technical skill that can be utilized by the IT Team, please contact me and you will be considered for the Team.

ELECTIONS 2022-2023 ANNUAL REPORT


We have succrssfully completed the 4 Quarters of Elections.

I do not have the fourth quarter as of this writing, but for those who enjoy numbers and details this should be plenty.


This is the first quarter by day.


