Time period covered: June 2024 to June 2025

When asked to provide an article for the Annual Report, I thought where do I start. As with all journeys, the best place to start is the beginning – so. In the beginning there was darkness---wait, stop, wrong story! I recently received a photo album from N8BGF – John through K8ZZ – Ed and the first page in the album is a note about the beginning.

"M A R A C – IT ALL STARTED HERE"

M A R A C – IT ALL ASTARTED HERE WHEN FIFTEEN OLD TIMER COUNTY HUNTERS MET AT THE HOLIDAY INN IN JACKSON, MISSISSIPPI ON MARCH 8 & 9, 1969. ENJOYMENT RAN RAMPANT AT THIS MEETING SO THE NEED FOR SO ANNUAL GET-TOGETHER WAS VERY EVIDENT. PLANS TOWARD THAT END WERE MADE AND MOUNTAIN HOME, ARKANSAS WAS CHOSEN AS THE SITE FOR <u>"THE FIRST ANNUAL</u> <u>COUNTY HUNTERS CONVENTION"</u>. STEVE, K5KDG, AGREED TO HOST THIS CONVENTION AND THE DATE WAS SET FOR THE WEEK-END OF JULY 4TH, 1969, SO THE LEG WORK FOR THIS AND FUTURE CONVENTIONS WAS OFF AND RUNNING.

AT THE MOUNTAIN HOME CONVENTION DETAILS WERE FINALIZED FOR OFFICERS, NAME, NEWSLETTER, BY LAWS, LEGALITIES, ETC.. THE KANSAS CITY GROUP AGREED TO WORK-OUT DETAILS WITH IRS, STATE LAWS, LEGALITIES, ETC., AND TO ESTABLISH HEADQUARTERS THERE.

ORIGIN OF THE FIRST MARAC CERTIFICATE, <u>"THE 303 AWARD"</u> WAS MADE AT THE MOUNTAIN HOME CONVENTION. I WILL VENTURE TO SAY THAT NO ONE ATTENDING THIS CONVENTION WILL EVER FORGET THE EVENTS OCCURING IN HOLIDAY INN'S <u>"ROOM 303"</u>.

SO THERE YOU HAVE SOME EXCERPTS FROM THE EARLY YEARS OF MARAC. AS THE EXPRESSION SOES: FROM SMALL ACORNS MIGHTY OAKS GROW.1

There can be no argument that MARAC has come a long way since those beginnings. From the days of monthly mailers from the Mobile QSL Bureau and the B & B Shop notifying us of planned trips, broken equipment, illnesses and silent keys. The days of "one-ringer" mobile county spots and paper logs/QSL Cards have been replaced by internet spots, logging programs and on-line chat apps. I wonder what the original group would think when hearing that MARAC has grown to now sponsoring the USA-CA Award!

Another year is in the books, with a few additions to the archives. Thank you to Shel Mann – N0DRX, John Sebastian – N8BGF and Ed Eklin -m K8ZZ for the materials. I continue to maintain and update a MARAC database to reflect the membership of all current and past members. I would like to note that in 2025, MARAC has created and established a USA-CA Award to replace now defunct CQ Magazine USA-CA Award. This was no small undertaking and I believe this may help expand MARAC's membership, potentially adding to more Mobile Activity. Also notable, is the increasing membership use of the Parks-On-The-Air (POTA) stations to make county contacts. Over the past year, our membership seems to have stabilized at about 300 members. I hope we will be able to increase that by 2026!

This Team is a dedicated volunteer group of MARAC Members who are working together to move the MARAC Awards Programs and Logger 2 Program into the future. Each has a unique skill that may have been learned in the commercial world or on their own, to improve the current Awards processing and Logger 2 programming.

The IT Team works in the background to help with Logger 2 programming, testing and support. Membership updates and corrections are done on a monthly basis. This database is used for member lookups, Logger updates, award information and much more.

Migration to Logger 2 continues with numerous conversions and new installations. Added functionality continues and implemented as it completes testing. New functions are easily added with a quick update.

Upgrade to Logger 2 is an easy update. Email KF7ZN to get on the installation schedule. If you are already a Logger user, there is no upgrade fee.

The IT Team has put in place the structure for the USA-CA award. This is complete, and a number of first time USA-CA awards have been issued.

If you have problems with Awards or Logger 2, please use the current method of problem reporting. Instead of posting on the forum, reach out directly to Dave, KE3VV, who will screen your problem for an existing fix and help you with a resolution.

If you have technical skill that can be utilized by the IT Team, please contact me and you will be considered for the Team.

ELECTIONS 2024-2025 ANNUAL REPORT


