ARRL Memberships

Thanks to those MARAC members who have supported MARAC in the past by submitting their ARRL regular or senior membership applications through the MARAC Secretary. These applications for <u>new</u> (includes lapsed over 2 years) or <u>renewal</u> memberships are processed on a monthly basis. Cutoff for each processing cycle is the last day of the previous month. For example, if your ARRL renewal requests its return by Sep 15, it should be received by the MARAC Secretary prior to Aug 15. For each ARRL membership, MARAC gets a commission of \$2 for a renewal and \$15 for a new membership. To take advantage of this, mail your ARRL membership application and a check made out to MARAC for the required dues to: MARAC Secretary, W0GXQ (address on back page).
