Remember that MARAC is now using a web-based system called Simply Voting for all of our voting needs. You will receive an email from Simply Voting containing instructions on voting and a password unique to you at the start date of the voting window. This e-mail provides two links for you to get to the voting page. The first requires you to enter your user ID and password, but the second takes you directly there, thus the second method shown is the simplest to use.

Please note that we no longer accept e-mail or regular mail ballots.

If you are a new member or are renewing following a lapse in membership, you are *not* eligible to submit nominations or vote in an election until the first day of the month following receipt of initial payment of dues and valid membership application to the Secretary of MARAC. Members maintaining uninterrupted membership status are not restricted from nominating or voting in the current month. Enter your call in Call Lookup and click Go to determine your MARAC expiration date.

General Election

Nominations will be open for 60 days - from January 5th through March 10th for the following District Directors:

North Central Director – 3 year term expiring 2020 South Central Director – 3 year term expiring 2020

Only members residing in these districts are eligible to vote.

Any current member of MARAC is eligible to run for office and you may nominate yourself or any other eligible member. If you nominate another person, you must get the consent of that person prior to submitting the nomination. For the District Director position, you must live within the District. Voting will occur in May, 2017. Please send your nomination to k7dm@centurylink.net not later than March 10th, 2017.

Voting will be open from January 15th through January 31st, 2017for the Best Net Control, Mobile, and Team awards. There are no nominees for these awards; you vote for the person or persons you feel are the most deserving.
