All MARAC members in good standing will be receiving a ballot from Simply Voting later this month. You will be voting for 4th quarter activity which includes the months of **April and May activity only**. The change has been made to coincide annual voting with the County Hunter of the Year award during the fourth quarter, when necessary.

No vote for County of the Year, in either category, CW or SSB will be held this year since only one nomination per mode was submitted. Winners will be announced by the board or awards manager at a later date.

No vote for the North Central and South Central Directors since both NF0N, Mike and KC5QCB, Janet agreed to serve another 2 year term, and were unopposed.

During June, the membership will also be voting on some by-law changes. A copy of those changes will be submitted to the membership to review prior to voting in a supplement to the newsletter. The email you receive from Simply Voting will contain a link and password for your ballot. Please follow the instructions once you have gone to the voting page.

If you are a NEW member or are REJOINING MARAC after a lapse in membership, you will NOT be eligible to vote until the first day of the month following receipt of your dues and valid membership application by the Secretary of MARAC.

Those individuals who have maintained uninterrupted membership status are not restricted from voting in the upcoming election.

If you are unsure of your membership status, please visit the MARAC website, click on COUNTY HUNTER DB, enter your call in the Call Look up to determine your MARAC Expiration Date.

The following awards will be voted on.

- CW & SSB Mobile of the Year
- CW & SSB Net Assist of the Year
- Team of the Year

Remember, you will receive two (2) reminder emails from Simply Voting. "IF" you have previously voted and receive a reminder email, it means you neglected to click on the SUBMIT button. Follow the instructions and try again. The system will not allow you to vote more than once.

If you have any questions regarding Simply Voting, please e-mail me and together we'll figure out the issue.

Don't forget to vote for the active mobiles &/or individuals who are assisting the mobiles by spotting and doing relays for them as well as the by-laws changes. Your support will be greatly appreciated.
