Across the top, two Samsung Monitors with Yosemite National Park on the screens which is where I was born in 1941. Dad was a ranger, mother was a telephone operator there. To the left is the WM-1 computing pwr-swr meter. Below are two DSP speakers which I don't use. To the right is the IC7300 with MFJ 993 tuner under. The white PVC is a very unique device for enhancing CW. It sits right over the speaker of the 7300. There is a data cable between the 7300 and 993 tuner. I do not use the internal tuner of the 7300. The 993 has a wider impedance range, also I run ladder line right to the tuner. There is a balun in the 993. No bulky balun to deal with. To the right is the Elecraft K3s / P3 Panadaptor. I haven't used this in quite awhile but will be shortly. The 7300 is a bunch of fun to operate. Beside the K3s is the paddle I consider priceless. Made in England and fortunate to have two of them. Out side is a +/- 600 feet horizontal loop up about 60 feet or so fed with 450 ladder line. As of today I am almost at the halfway point of 6th time all CW.....Tom N4RS

ARRL on the Purpose of Amateur Radio:

For over 100 years amateur radio and ARRL — the National Association for Amateur Radio® — have stood for the development of the science and art of communications, public service, and the enhancement of international goodwill. Amateur Radio's long history and service to the public has solidified the well-earned reputation that "Amateur Radio saves lives."

Amateur Radio Operators, due to their history of public service, their training, and the requirement that they be licensed by the FCC have earned their status as a component of critical communications infrastructure and as a reliable resource "when all else fails."

Amateur Radio is about development of communications and responsible public service. Its misuse is inconsistent with its history of service and its statutory charter. ARRL does not support its misuse for purposes inconsistent with these values and purposes.

CHOTY Award Schedule for 2021

Nominations are Now Open for County Hunter of the Year – SSB and CW

Nominations open February 1st for CHOTY for the 12-month period of activity ending January 31, 2021. Nominations must be submitted to your respective District Director for consideration by the deadline specified later in this document.

Objective of the County Hunter of the Year Award

From the current rule for County Hunter of the Year – SSB and CW in MARAC's Award Rules document (page 16), subsection "Objective":

"To recognize members of MARAC who have made a significant overall contribution to MARAC and county hunting during the 12 months immediately prior to start of nominations for this award."

New Eligibility Requirements for this Year's Nominees

During 2020, the Board of Directors proposed a change to the MARAC Bylaws to the membership which allowed restrictions for receipt of certain awards to current members of MARAC (which is determined by verifying their membership has not expired). This proposal was voted on by the membership in June 2020 and was approved. That result was announced at the July, 2020 annual meeting. Later in 2020, the Board of Directors voted to change the definition of the term "Eligibility for MARAC Awards" to read (in part) as follows:

"MARAC Awards are available to any licensed amateur radio operator anywhere in the world except that the **County Hunter of the Year**, Mobile Assist of the Year, Mobile Team of the Year, and Mobile of the Year Awards may only be received by a member of MARAC,"

That change was voted on 12/7/2020 and is now in effect and is included in the current rules version dated 12/7/2020 on the MARAC website (page 7).

Special Rules Pertaining to the CHOTY Award

From the current rule for County Hunter of the Year – SSB and CW in MARAC's Award Rules document (page 16), subsection "Special Rules":

"The recipients of this award are determined by an annual ballot of the MARAC membership. The vote is conducted before each annual meeting. The candidates for the award are nominated by MARAC District Directors.

Each District Director may select one nominee for each category (SSB/CW) to be placed on the ballot from among the nominees submitted by MARAC members from that Director's district.

The District Director must receive nominations not later than the end of the fourth month preceding the annual meeting or by the deadline announced in the MARAC newsletter.

The District Director must forward his or her selection and reasons for the nomination to the Awards Manager by the middle of the following month.

If the Awards Manager receives more than three nominations for a category, the Awards Committee will select the three nominees for each category for the ballot.

If less than three nominations are received from District Directors, the Awards Committee may select additional nominees to bring the number of nominees for the ballot up to three.

Criteria for consideration for County Hunter of the Year include the following:

1. Quality and quantity of operating to provide **Valid Contacts** from multiple counties while in **Mobile Operation** or while assisting mobile county hunters as a Net Control Station (NCS) or assistant NCS.
2. Participation in MARAC activities and service to MARAC and the members of MARAC.
3. Other activities in support of county hunting.
4. Technical proficiency in design or usage or implementation of enhancements to mobile operation or county hunting net operations. Overall amateur radio general support in a manner consistent with good operation and advancement of the hobby.
5. Member qualification must be based on his/her activities during the previous 12 months, ending on the first day that nominations are accepted.
6. MARAC Board members are eligible for this award. However, consideration should not be based upon their fulfillment of their board duties. Their consideration must be based upon activity outside of this such as mobile activity, net assistance activity, spotting activity, service to other members, and general overall enhancement of county hunting.
7. A member of MARAC may receive this award multiple times for each category, however, only once every three years for the same category."

List of Recent Winners Ineligible for Nomination in the Same Category in 2021

With regard to criteria #7 above, members who won a particular category in the previous two years are ineligible to be nominees for that same category in the current year. Previous winners of the SSB category include:

2019 - AB7NK

2020 - K7SEN

Previous winners of the CW category include:

2019 - AB7RW

2020 - KC3X

Please do not nominate any of these individuals for the same category they won in either of the previous two years since they are ineligible in 2021.

Submission of Nominations

Nominations should be sent to the District Director of the district in which the intended nominee resides. Below is information regarding which states are included in a particular MARAC district and

Documentation Contained in Nomination Submission

The nomination documentation should include:

1. a written justification of why this nominee should be awarded the County Hunter of the Year award for: a) the designated 12 month activity period (2/1/20 through 1/31/21), and b) the specific category (SSB or CW) that the nominee is being nominated for. If possible, it would be very helpful to members to know the quantity of activity during the 12 month period such as:
 - number of days of mobile activity by the nominee for this category
 - number of counties transmitted from (total for all trips)
 - number of bands typically transmitted from in each county for this category
 - number of miles driven (total for all trips)
 - total number of contacts made during the year on all bands/modes whether mobile, portable, or fixed (if using Logger subtract the first contact number on the 1st day of the period from the last contact number on the last day of the period).

That justification will eventually be published in the RoadRunner and on the electronic ballot if the individual is recommended by their District Director to be a nominee from that district for either the SSB or CW category.

2. A brief biography of the nominee pertaining to their participation in county hunting.

Deadline for Nominations from the Membership

This year's deadline for nominations to be received by the District Directors is **Tuesday, March 9th**.

I encourage all members to participate in: a) nominating deserving members for this award, b) voting in the elections (if held), and c) congratulating the ultimate winners and runners-up after the results are announced.

Nominations Now Open for County Hunter of the Year – SSB and CW

Nominations open February 1st for CHOTY for the 12-month period of activity ending January 31, 2021. Read all the procedural details in a separate article in this issue of the RoadRunner. That article also has a schedule for each of the steps which must take place to complete the nomination process, publication of the nominees, and electronic voting by the membership to determine the winners.

Problem with USA – SSB book in Logger 1

Please be aware that the “USA – SSB” book in Logger 1 apparently did not calculate and post entries properly the entire time since it was approved in 2015. The start date for that award is February 5, 2015, therefore no contacts prior to that date should be included in the “book” for that award. I recently realized that my book summary page indicated I had completed that award. However, when I checked sample pages of contacts, I found many contacts all the way back to 2001 when I started county hunting.

To determine if recalculation of the book would fix this issue, I updated my master file and recalculated that book and now it appears to be correct (using version 5175). If you are using an older version of Logger 1, you should update your master file and your version of Logger and then recalculate this book. Note: when you recalculate, it will present you a list of about one week of contacts starting on or after 2/5/15 and it asks you to select the first contact to be counted towards that award. Please select the first valid contact before continuing with the recalc.

After recalculation completes, I suggest you spot check a few states to verify that no contacts before the start date are appearing in the log entries. If you intend to apply for this award in the future, we would appreciate it if you would do the process above to verify that the data is good (compliant with the rule start date for all 3,077 counties) before you apply for the award.


