




County Hunter of the Year-Congrats!!

One way to support them and show appreciation is through voting.

With that in mind, we will be having our fourth quarter voting in June. This voting will cover March, April, and May. This will go out to all members in good standing, each of whom will receive an email from Simply Voting. The voting period will go from the 5th to the 20th of June. That gives everyone about two weeks to complete their voting. I will send the results to Ron N5MLP, who is the awards manager, and the board.

The email you receive from Simply Voting will contain a link and a password for your ballot. Please follow the instructions once you have gone to the voting page.

If you are a new member or are rejoining MARAC after a lapse in membership, you will not be eligible to vote until the first day of the month following receipt of your dues and valid membership application by the Secretary of MARAC. Those individuals who have maintained uninterrupted membership status will be eligible to vote in the upcoming election.

If you are unsure of your membership status, please visit the MARAC website, click on county hunter DB, enter your call in the Call Look up and you will find your expiration date.

As has been mentioned already, no vote will be needed for the Great Lakes and Southeast Directors, since both Kerry W4SIG and Darl NA8W agreed to serve another 2-year term, and were unopposed, and no vote will be needed for County Hunter of the Year.

The following awards will be voted on.

- CW & SSB Mobile of the Year
- CW & SSB Net Assist of the Year
- Team of the Year

Remember, if you have not voted, you will receive two (2) reminder emails from Simply Voting. If you have previously voted and receive a reminder email, it probably means you forgot to click on the submit button. Follow the instructions and try again. The system will not allow you to vote more than once.

If you have any questions regarding Simply Voting, please e-mail me and we'll see if we can figure out the issue. This will be my second election and I am hoping I have everything right this time, but of course if not, feel free to let me know.




