Known Issue with Confirmation Email for Last County Submissions

Notice from the Awards Secretary, AB7RW:

Problem with Last County receipts

I did not receive a receipt for my last county submission. What should I do? WAIT. Do not send a duplicate application when you don't receive a receipt.

There is a known problem with our internet provider that prevents the receipts from being transmitted. The provider is aware of the problem; however, there is no fix in sight

This is the solution: WAIT until AB7RW posts awards on the Forum. Next go to the website marac.org, then CountyHunter DB, then Last County Lookup. Enter the callsign of the application that you are concerned about, and check the list to see if your application is posted.

So far, the awards program has received and posted 100% of the applications. All you need is a little patience and understanding. I appreciate that you are checking to follow up on your applications to make sure that they get awarded.

In addition to checking to see if your application has been posted, it would be a good idea to check on your application before you click on SUBMIT. This is where many errors happen.
