Home and Mobile Shacks

This month featuring “Boots” by KA2LHO

Here is my secondary mobile shack!

My 2006 PT Cruiser restoration project (Boots!) includes a complete HF SSB/CW setup with a Yaesu ATAS 120A antenna identical to our primary mobile setup in our 2017 Explorer (Dora).

Inside the two vehicles are setup differently. Boots has an ICOM 5100 for VHF/UHF communications which is the same equipment that our County Sheriff's Ham Radio

Team uses as part of our disaster response shelter communications. A separate VHF/UHF antenna is installed for maximum efficiency.

For HF Boots has a Yaesu FT-891 installed. Both vehicles have an N3ZN Mini-Mite paddle so I have a consistent touch when I switch vehicles.

Dora is our "road trip" vehicle and locally my wife uses that. That has a Yaesu FT-857D for HF, VHF and UHF with the aforementioned ATAS and a separate VHF/UHF antenna.

Boots is my project and what I drive locally.

New Amateur Radio License Applications Fee

To Become Effective April 19, 2022

A Public Notice released by the Federal Communications Commission (FCC) on March 23, 2022, in [MD Docket No. 20-270](#), announced that new application fees for Wireless Telecommunications Bureau applications will become effective on April 19, 2022. The new fees, mandated by Congress, apply to applications for Amateur Radio licenses including those associated with filing Form 605, the Amateur Operator/Primary Station Licensee Application.

Effective April 19, 2022, a \$35 fee will apply to applications for a new Amateur Radio license, modification (upgrade and sequential call sign change), renewal, and vanity call signs.



Anticipating the implementation of the fee in 2022, the ARRL Board of Directors, at its July 2021 meeting, approved the "ARRL [Youth Licensing Grant Program](#)." Under the program, ARRL will cover a one-time \$35 application fee for license candidates younger than 18 years old for tests administered under the auspices of the ARRL Volunteer Examiner Coordinator (ARRL VEC). Qualified candidates also would pay a reduced exam session fee of \$5 to the ARRL VEC. ARRL is finalizing details for administering the program.



ARRL had filed comments in opposition to imposing a fee on Amateur Radio license applications. The FCC initially proposed a higher, \$50 fee. In a Report and Order (R&O), released on December 29, 2020, the amount was reduced -- the FCC agreeing with ARRL and other commenters that its proposed \$50 fee for certain amateur radio applications was "too high to account for the minimal staff involvement in these applications."

ARRL Volunteer Examiner Coordinator (ARRL VEC) Manager Maria Somma, AB1FM, explained that all fees are per application. "There will be no fee for administrative updates, such as a change of mailing or email address. The fees will be the responsibility of the applicant regardless of filing method and must be paid within 10 calendar days of FCC's receipt of the application. For applications filed by a VEC, the period does not begin until the application is received by the Commission, a ULS file number assigned, and an email sent by the FCC directly to the applicant."

VECs and Volunteer Examiner (VE) teams will not collect the \$35 fee at license exam sessions. New and upgrade candidates at an exam session will continue to pay the \$15 exam session fee to the ARRL VE team as usual, and pay the new, \$35 application fee directly to the FCC by using the CORES FRN Registration system ([CORES - Login](#)).

When the FCC receives the examination information from the VEC, it will email a link with payment instructions to each successful candidate who then will have 10 calendar days from the date of the email to pay. After the fee is paid and the FCC has processed an application, examinees will receive a second email from the FCC with a link to their official license or explanation of other action. The link will be good for 30 days.

Somma also explained that applications that are processed and dismissed will not be entitled to a refund. This includes vanity call sign requests where the applicant does not receive the requested call sign. "The FCC staff has suggested that applicants for vanity call signs should first ensure the call signs requested are available and eligible for their operator class and area, and then request as many call signs as the form allows to maximize their chances of receiving a call sign."

MARAC SECRETARY DUTIES:

- Is Elected by MARAC membership for a term of 2 years. Can volunteer to serve subsequent terms
- Notifies Board members of date, time, and location of upcoming Board of Director meetings, along with proposed Agenda

- Notifies MARAC webmaster prior to an official Board meeting so that notice can be created at least 7 days prior to a meeting
 - Notifies Board members of date and time of conference calls needed for discussing club business
 - Creates, from Board input, a meeting Agenda
 - Attends and participates in Board conference calls and official BOD meetings. Votes on motions made. Conference calls are usually monthly, official Board meetings are roughly 4 per year.
 - Takes the minutes during a Board of Directors Meeting
 - After each meeting, distributes a draft of the minutes for Board members to review. A final copy of these minutes should be attached to the agenda of the next Board meeting so that they can be voted upon for final approval. These minutes are then sent to the MARAC webmaster for posting on the marac.org website
 - Keeps a list of topics for Board discussion at each monthly conference call.
 - Either runs each meeting, or assigns another Board member to run it for him/her.
 - Gathers required reports from MARAC positions needed to create the Annual Report each July meeting. Distributes this annual report to the Board for approval. Then sends a copy to the webmaster for publishing on the MARAC website

Significant Changes to Master Gold Award were Approved

As a result of a request from one of the board members last fall, the board discussed the current service hour requirements associated with the award, the fact that all appointed or elected positions were not listed to receive service credit for their service to the club, and the difficulty for some members to attain the necessary credits to complete the award since the formal nets were not currently being held and people could not earn service credit for service as a Net Control or Assistant Net Control operator. It was therefore determined that the Awards Committee should review the existing award rule and recommend possible changes that should be considered by the board to improve the possibility that operators could achieve the service requirements necessary to finish Master Gold.

The Awards Committee undertook that review in November and December of 2021 and made a series of recommendations to the board in late December. The recommendations included:

- A reduction in the total number of service hours required to achieve the award
- Adjustments to the assigned values for service credit that could be earned by some of those members currently serving in elected or appointed positions
- Addition of other elected or appointed positions which had not previously been specified to receive credits
- Addition of a provision for anyone other than those specified who provides a service to MARAC to be able to claim service credit on the basis of actual hours spent

One consideration that was discussed during these deliberations was to increase the annual service credits for some elected/appointed positions in order to improve the likelihood that members will volunteer to serve the club in the various positions which are now vacant or become vacant in the future.

At the March 14th meeting of the MARAC Board of Directors most of the recommended changes to the Master Gold Award were approved to become effective on April 1st, 2022. A revised copy of the award rules dated 4/1/2022 has been prepared and will be posted on the MARAC website on or before that date.

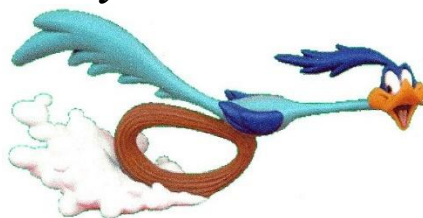
