Award Highlight- No Stars Award

This month it is time to highlight the MARAC "No Stars Award". This award was established back on January 1, 2010 and is not an easy one to accomplish. Only 2 county hunters have finished this feat so far. There are no levels to this award (i.e. 1000, 2000, etc), so all 3077 counties must be worked to achieve this award. This award was created to energize mobile operators who haven't gotten their USACA award (Star) yet and increase the number of county hunters making contacts with such stations. Also, the advent of Parks on the Air creates a huge source of Portable contacts that count toward this award.

Of special note is that ONLY valid contacts with operators in Mobile or Portable operation count for this award. This means that Home stations do NOT county. The accuracy of logging contacts comes into play here. If you might note, Logger defaults every Contact Op"eration as a "Mobile Contact". You can change this field to "Home", "Portable", "Remote", or even "Unknown". For example, if you work W1ABC in a state QSO party and don't take the time to update this field, this contact will automatically enter it as Mobile, thusly giving you credit for the No Stars award for the county that W1ABC is in. Was this station mobile? Was it remote? Or was it someone sitting in their den? If you do not know, you should update this field to "Unknown". You can, of course, ask the station. However, if they are in the midst of a fast-paced contest, you probably won't get the opportunity to clarify this. I can state that, throughout the years, I have taken extreme care to make sure I log such contacts accurately so as to not get credit for the No Star award when it is not due. However, I am sure that I, no doubt, have let some slip. I have been interested and have tracked this award since its inception. However, if you have not been tracking this book all along, you probably didn't care what entry was in the Contact Operator field. So, your numbers for the No Star award are probably way off. Not much you can do at this point.

Another point of contention is what to do about a mobile who has obtained their star that is using his/her own callsign PLUS a club callsign that does NOT have a star. Should you count that contact as credit for the No Stars award? For example, I have multiple stars which means any contacts with W4SIG/m since I received my first star in 2010 do not count for the No Stars award. But I also have access to a club call KP2C,

which has no stars. So, if I operate as W4SIG/KP2C/m, should you be able to count this contact for the No Stars award? I have heard debate both ways on this. Technically speaking, I think it should count. But I do think this goes against the spirit of the award and why it was created in the first place. As a result, I personally would make sure that I do NOT get No Star credit for this contact. I would follow this same train of thought to an extreme...let's say I get permission from multiple clubs to use their club callsigns on a mobile trip. I could then operate as W4SIG/KP2C/AA3RQ/N7HN/WB5ABC/etc so as to count for every MARAC Prefix and Callsign combo award that exists. But I am only one operator. So should I be able to operate using all these calls giving credit for them all (including the No Stars award)? My personal opinion is that since this can get out of hand, I choose to only count the contact of the callsign of the operator him/herself. What do you think? This could lead to considerable debate, of course.

Back to the No Star award, here it is as described in the MARAC Award Rules. If you haven't tracked it in Logger yet, give it a shot as you might be closer than you realize. Who knows who will be the third recipient?

USA-No Stars Award

OBJECTIVE: To make contacts with amateur radio operators who have not received the USA-CA Award and to encourage new county hunters to transmit counties while mobile.

SPECIAL RULES: A Star is defined in General Rules and Definitions for MARAC Awards. Only Valid Contacts with operators in Mobile or Portable Operation who have no Stars may be used for this award. If an operator has one or more Stars, only contacts made with that operator before the date that the USA-CA Award was issued to that operator may be counted for this award.

All contacts must be made on or after January 1, 2010.

AWARD LEVELS: No intermediate levels. USA-No Stars is awarded for working All USA Counties.

After completing USA-No Stars, each sequential award (USA-No Stars II, USA-No Stars III, etc.) can be worked by Starting Over and working All USA Counties again for the sequential award.

APPLICATION AND FEES:

Standard application, logs, and fees.

Opening - MARAC Awards Manager By Kerry W4SIG

Please consider volunteering for this important MARAC role. Contact any Board member for more info. The description of the position is stated below.

Responsibilities/Duties of the MARAC Awards Manager

- Administers the MARAC Awards program in accordance with the policies and procedures adopted by the Board of Directors
- 2. Acts as the chairperson of the Awards Committee, which creates and considers proposals for new MARAC awards or changes to existing awards
- 3. Maintains the official MARAC Award Rules document and ensures that all rule changes are published in a timely manner after they are approved by the Board of Directors on both:
 - a. The MARAC Awards subsection of the MARAC website, and
 - b. The Awards Committee section of the monthly newsletter to members.
- 4. Initiates reviews of new awards or modifications to existing awards by the Awards Committee. Suggestions for award additions or modifications may originate from awards committee members, members of MARAC (including but not limited to officers/directors), or outside persons not currently members of MARAC.
- 5. Establishes the timeline for the process to determine winners of certain MARAC awards which occur on a recurring basis each year, including:
 - County Hunter of the Year SSB/CW, Mobile of the Year-SSB/CW, Mobile Assist of the Year-SSB/CW, Mobile Team of the Year
- 6. Communicates to the Election Coordinator when electronic elections should occur to support the determination of award winners listed in section 5 above. Also, notifies the Election Coordinator during the execution of the process whether electronic elections will not be required for certain awards (e. g., County

Hunter of the Year) if there was only one nominee identified during the nomination process.

- 7. Creates and publishes notifications in the monthly newsletter when the nomination process for County Hunter of the Year – SSB and CW actually begins and the subsequent deadlines that must be followed in order for members and Directors to complete and submit their nominations to support the determination process.
- 8. Ensures that the activities in items 5, 6, and 7 supports conclusions on each of the annual awards by June so that the information can be incorporated in the annual MARAC report to the membership and is annual cat the MARAC annual meeting in July.
- 9. Responds to inquiries from the Board of Directors or any member concerning: a) award rules, or b) interpretation of the rules.
- 10. Oversees the activities of the Award Secretary to support:
 - a. Processing of applications for awards from members and non-members
 - b. Creation of certificates and plaques requested by members which are supported by electronic applications.
 - c. Reporting of cost expenditures for the awards function to the MARAC Treasurer who receives payments from members, pays invoices from plaque/award vendors, or reimburses the Awards Secretary for other expenses including office supplies, computer equipment purchase/maintenance, shipping costs, etc.
 - d. Timely reporting of awards issued to the membership using various vehicles including but not limited to the monthly newsletter articles and direct posts to the K3IMC forum or CountyHunter.com website.
 - e. Acquisition of plaques, trophies, etc. from appropriate vendors of such items.
- 11. Authors a monthly Awards Committee article to the *RoadRunner* editor (by the date specified by the *RoadRunner* editor) for inclusion in the monthly newsletter. As a minimum, one section of each month's article should include a summary of all awards issued during the month. Special topics within the article may address new award types which have been recently approved, clarification of award rules, changes in online application forms, information about known award processing issues in the computer systems supporting awards, or other topics of interest regarding awards to the membership.
- 12. Handles awards related special tasks as assigned by the MARAC Board of Directors.
