### **USA-CA** Records Update

Many of you are likely aware that in the beginning of November, 2024 I took on the task of manually transcribing all of the public USA-CA records for each level of the award for the past 63 years into a complete electronic form of storage and retrieval, and to which the 6 individuals who served as USA-CA Custodians for CQ Magazine over those 63 years never had access.

This task took at least 7-8 full weeks of daily work and included reaching out to specific people for data that nobody else had. The amount of information I collected while doing the work for this project was incredibly educational and motivating. Nearly 13,000 USA-CA records were transcribed into the new MARAC USA-CA Records Custodian Excel workbook, a [Search] Tool was programmed which may be utilized to make USA-CA record maintenance easier and more efficient going forward, and workbook documentation was written and completed.

My goals for doing this work were 100% in support of MARAC and its effort to sponsor a NEW USA-CA program which is designed to carry on in the tradition and prestige of the former CQ Magazine-sponsored USA-CA. This work was also done to honor the 6 individuals who unselfishly served as volunteer CQ Magazine USA-CA Custodians and spent so many hours processing nearly 13,000 USA-CAs for nearly 3,800 different recipients and writing a monthly [Awards] column in the magazine over a period of 63 years.

All of us on this thread know that MARAC, whose primary purpose is to support mobiling and county hunting, and is the premier organization for doing so, is also the only logical and responsible organization that is most equipped and actually has a system and the mechanics to be able to assign and issue new USA-CAs.

As of this writing, MARAC has already assigned and issued 15 new USA-CAs between the 500 and 2000 level to 8 different people, so it is now well on its way to establishing itself as the sponsor of a new and <u>real</u> USA-CA program, which seems to quickly be gaining popularity in the mobiling and county hunting communities.

### **Upcoming By-Laws Change Vote**

At the last MARAC Board meeting on Jan 20, 2025 the Board approved putting a By-Laws change on the next outgoing ballot. Keep an eye out for this so that you are prepared to vote on it. The next ballot will probably be coming your way in early March. The purpose of this proposed change is to create a new club position called the USACA Records Custodian. Here is the Board motion and the discussion:

#### Motion:

The following paragraph is added to the MARAC Bylaws:

5.5(h) USA-CA Records Custodian. The President may appoint a regular member of MARAC to serve as United States of America County Award Records Custodian. The person in this position shall be responsible for maintenance and enhancement of the Records Database for the United States of America County Award by:

- Keeping the 7 sub-tables of the award updated to ensure the Awards Secretary has accurate data available
- Supplying missing award dates when they become available
- Performing Typo corrections
- Keeping accurate and up-to-date Call Sign histories for USA-CA recipients
- Coupling Call ID data field to USA-CA list maintenance
- Providing checks and balances to MARAC front page and expanded USA-CA MARAC DB listings

Discussion: Since MARAC decided to offer awards for all the lower levels (500, 1000, etc) of the USA-CA award, this created a very complex issue of creating an accurate digital database of all the previous levels issued by CQ Magazine with their version of the award. Barry, K2MF, has done an extraordinary job of researching the manual CQ records of 63 years and completing this task as accurately as possible. He has created these 7 workbooks and has made them available to the MARAC Awards Secretary for use. However, there is a lot of missing data that will continually need to be updated and added to these workbooks. For example, out of 13,000 awards issued during the 63 years, almost 4,000 of them still have missing issue dates. Information continues to trickle in from past recipients. All of these tasks, as highlighted above, should be formalized in an official MARAC USA-CA Records Custodian role.

If you do not have Logger II yet I would encourage you to do so soon. This program just works so well. It is worth your time and money. Don K3IMC has done a marvelous job with it.

Here is a description of the role and its responsibilities.

Responsibilities of MARAC District Director:

- Shall adopt all policies of MARAC in accordance with the provisions of the Bylaws
- Serves a 3-year term, with the option of volunteering for subsequent terms
- Participates in Board discussions regarding topics related to MARAC. This can be via email or during periodic (usually monthly) conference calls
- Attend and participate in official Board Meetings via conference call. These meetings are held when needed, usually about 4 per year. During these meetings make motions and vote on orders of business. This includes the MARAC annual Board meeting usually held in July.
- Act as a focal point of communications for members of your District when issues or questions arise.
- Serve as a liaison of communications to an appointed MARAC position
- Be creative in finding ways to assist MARAC in supporting its members and growing our club

Call Meeting to order. Time: 9 PM EST

5.5(h) USA-CA Records Custodian. The President may appoint a regular member of MARAC to serve as United States of America County Award Records Custodian. The person in this position shall be responsible for maintenance and enhancement of the Records Database for the United States of America County Award by:

- Keeping the 7 sub-tables of the award updated to ensure the Awards Secretary has accurate data available
- Supplying missing award dates when they become available
- Performing Typo corrections
- Keeping accurate and up-to-date Call Sign histories for USA-CA recipients
- Coupling Call ID data field to USA-CA list maintenance
- Providing checks and balances to MARAC front page and expanded USA-CA MARAC DB listings

Discussion: Since MARAC decided to offer awards for all the lower levels (500, 1000, etc) of the USA-CA award, this created a very complex issue of creating an accurate digital database of all the previous levels issued by CQ Magazine with their version of the award. Barry, K2MF, has done an extraordinary job of researching the manual CQ

records of 63 years and completing this task as accurately as possible. He has created these 7 workbooks and has made them available to the MARAC Awards Secretary for use. However, there is a lot of missing data that will continually need to be updated and added to these workbooks. For example, out of 13,000 awards issued during the 63 years, almost 4,000 of them still have missing issue dates. Information continues to trickle in from past recipients. All of these tasks, as highlighted above, should be formalized in an official MARAC USA-CA Records Custodian role.

While the Board approved this, it will need to be on a future ballot for membership vote since it is a By-Laws change. Also, advance notice of this should be included in the next RoadRunner. The Board also agrees that this position should qualify for 300 hours/yr credit toward the Masters Gold award, similar to other appointed positions. This will be a future motion.
